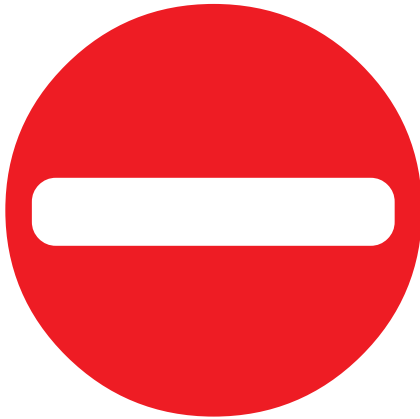

A fairer admissions system for Hove - no thanks to the Tories

In Goldsmid we don't believe in knocking other political parties. Nearly everything you receive from us is about our own values and policies. But we have made an exception on the issue of secondary school admissions.

The reason is that the Conservatives have voted three times against a fairer school admissions system, one which gives local families access to Hove's two secondary schools.

This is such a triple whammy for local families that we think it would be irresponsible of us not to let you know.

Plans for a BN3 catchment area for Hove secondary schools have been agreed with support not just from Labour, but also from other political parties. This will deliver a fair admissions system for Goldsmid families, children won't be bussed out of Hove to get to school.

We have achieved this despite Tory opposition. In fact, the Conservative alternative proposals would have made the existing distance-based system even worse. Instead of just a part of the community facing annual uncertainty, the whole of Goldsmid ward would have been hit.

This ward is a Tory target for the City Council elections in May. But we don't think they actually understand our community's priorities. Do you?
